Abstract: Daily livelihood of the people is inexorably intertwined with the computer and digital technologies and an underdeveloped country like Bhutan is no exception. Within last decades, internet users have been exponentially increasing which will inevitably result in the rise of the cybercrime. It is crucial to create awareness among the general public which may not eradicate cybercrime from the root but could possibly reduce the rate of cybercrime.
